Re: PMRN Rostering

It's a great day:

Version 3 of the PMRN, the K-2 Electronics Scoring Tool, and the 3-12 WAM are all online and ready for the Florida Assessments for Instruction in Reading to begin.

For the optional early submission of data, of the 72 districts using the Florida Assessments for Instruction in Reading, 46 districts are reported to have transmitted student AND staff demographic files to the Northwest Regional Data Center (NWRDC) for collection by the FLDOE's Bureau of Education Information and Accountability Services (EIAS). Four districts submitted one of the two required files. In the dataset received by the Florida Center for Reading Research, there were student and staff demographic files for 40 districts.

PMRN rostering by the numbers:

Schools:	2,023
Teachers:	57,550
Students:	1,129,255

At the district level, there are as few as one student at one school rostered to as many as 149,167 students at 371 schools.

Please be reminded that for a student to be rostered in the PMRN, s/he must have a responsible reading instructor listed in the Student Demographic file and the staff member must be listed in the Staff Demographic file.

The next submission cycle begins with the initial set of files uploaded to the NWRDC being processed at 10:00 AM ET on Friday, September 4 and ending with the processing of the batch updates submitted to the NWRDC by 9:00 PM ET on Thursday, September 10. Rosters should be ready in the by 8:00 AM ET, Monday, September 14 with a guarantee of Thursday, September 17.

I will check with EIAS on Monday to see if the files for the six districts were processed. If they were processed, we will import them into the PMRN early this week.
