

## 2010-2011 Florida Assessments for Instruction in Reading (FAIR) Calendar

Data collection and score entry using the electronic components of the Florida Assessments for Instruction in Reading (FAIR) may begin on Monday, August 30 or the school's sixth instructional day – whichever is later.

The electronic components supporting the Florida Assessments are:

- 1) Progress Monitoring and Reporting Network (PMRN)
- 2) K-2 Electronic Scoring Tool (K-2 EST)
- 3) K-2 Adobe Integrated Runtime (K-2 AIR)
- 4) 3-12 Web-based Assessment Module (3-12 WAM)

In order for a student to be assessed using the K-2 EST, K-2 AIR, or 3-12 WAM, s/he must be rostered in a class in the PMRN. The PMRN will allow the management of class rosters beginning on Monday, August 23.

- Lockdown – no score entry or scoring may take place
- Data Collection – norming window during which all rostered students should be assessed
- "Make-up"--scoring and data entry can take place. Scores entered during this time are displayed only on those reports that show an individual student's name, and are denoted with a dagger (†) next to the score; scores entered during this time are not included in reports with aggregate calculations.

An Instructional Day is a weekday when students are in session. The first Norming/Data Collection Window is scheduled to begin on the school's sixth Instructional Day. All three Norming/Data Collection Windows are usually 35 Instructional Days in length. Because the electronic components of the FAIR are not scheduled for release until August 30, the first Norming/Data Collection Window for some schools must be adjusted.

Schools that begin prior to August 23 may assess students with the paper and pencil K-2 Student Score Booklet and input scores using the Data Entry Page; entry of these scores can begin on August 30.
