



Sound Bags

Objective

The student will match medial phonemes in words.

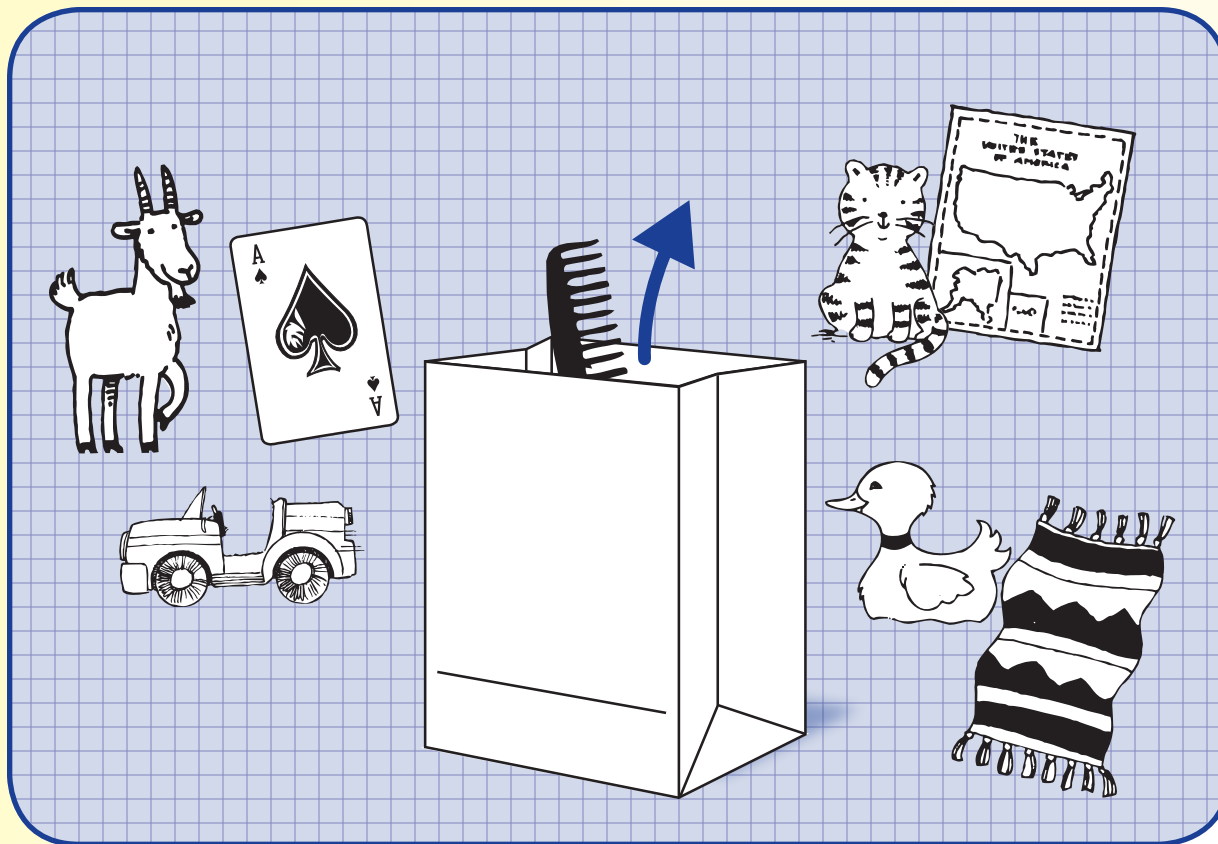
Materials

- ▶ Paper bag
- ▶ Pairs of objects with the same medial sounds
Place one object from each pair in the bag.

Activity

Students match objects with the same medial sound.

1. Place the bag and the objects at the center.
2. Taking turns, student one pulls out an object, names it, and says the medial sound (e.g., “comb, /ō/”).
3. Student two finds the object that has the matching medial sound, names it, and says the medial sound (i.e., “goat, /ō/”). Puts the matching pair aside.
4. Continue until all objects are paired.
5. Peer evaluation



Extensions and Adaptations

- ▶ Use initial or final sound objects.
- ▶ Use medial sounds of a pair of objects as clues and partner identifies objects.
